Why are we here ?

- EURIM meeting “Driving the Digital Single Market” chaired by Malcom Harbour on 23rd January
- Part of EURIM and EIF joint work
- Discussion focused on
 - key issues with greatest information and identity governance impact
 - Areas/ initiatives that need to be subjected to joined-up scrutiny;
- Objective to look at producing agreed recommendations on policy priorities
- Key issue identified was data protection

STORY SO FAR...

- October 2009 – EU Commission Questionnaire
- July 2010 - Stakeholder questionnaire and meetings
- November 2010 Commission Communication
- December 2011– leaked versions of Commission proposals
- 25th January 2012– Commission finally published proposals

- UK MOJ Call for Evidence – Closed in early March
 - **“How will these proposals affect you, or the bodies you represent?”**

on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by competent authorities for the purposes of prevention, investigation, detection or prosecution of criminal offences or the execution of criminal penalties, and the free movement of such data

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What is being proposed

- Regulation not a Directive
- Regulation now includes 91 Articles - including amongst other things....
 - Extension of EU law outside EU
 - Changes to definition of personal data
 - Explicit Consent
 - Clarity on applicable law – lead DPA based on main establishment
 - Profiling
 - Data Controller and Processor responsibilities
 - Data Breach Notification
 - Privacy by Design and Privacy by Default requirements
 - Data Portability
 - Right to be Forgotten
 - Sanctions and financial penalties
 - Proposed European Data Protection Board
