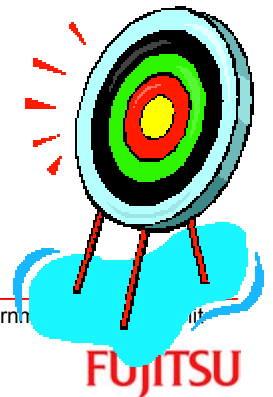


The Causeway Vision

“All the information shared within the criminal justice system will be accurate, consistent, up-to-date and accessible electronically by the staff who have a need to use it.”

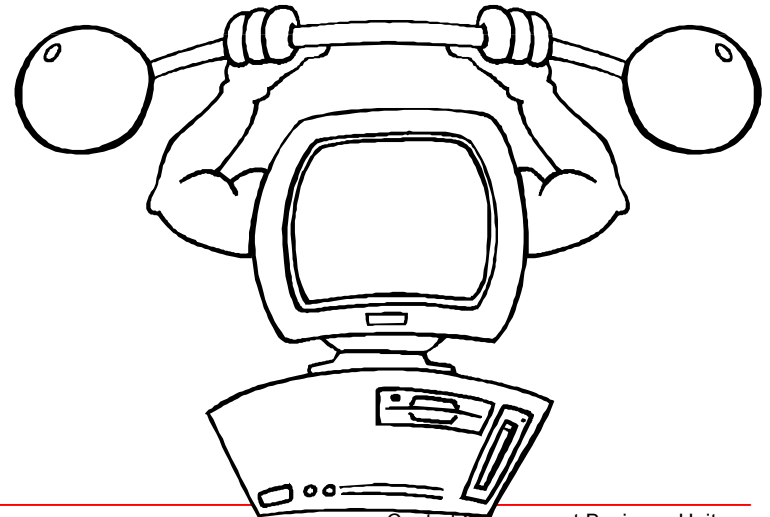
Causeway Identified Benefits
