

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

- (1) The European Internet Foundation (EIF) and the Information Society Alliance (EURIM) agree to work together to improve political understanding of information society issues at the national and European level.
  
- (2) The initial stages of the cooperation will include:
  - 2.1. exchange of programme information;
  - 2.2. invitations to EURIM political members to attend EIF meetings in Brussels;
  - 2.3. invitations to EIF members to attend EURIM meetings in London;
  - 2.4. invitations to EIF members to participate in relevant EURIM policy studies;
  - 2.5. cross-linkage between EURIM and EIF website;
  - 2.6. Joint projects as mutually agreed\*.
  
- (3) Except as may be separately agreed, this MoU does not lead to the commitment of resources or reimbursement of funds between the two parties.
  
- (4) The areas of cooperation and the ensuing activities will be regularly reviewed to assess the need for or adequacy of any adjustments.
  
- (5) This MoU will start from the date hereof and will continue until either Party gives notice, in writing, of their desire to terminate this agreement.
